NATURAL COLOUR. NON CHILL-FILTERED. 46%VOL.

SNIPPET:

*Zesty, round, full of spice and soft ripe fruit
Warm caramel, candied orange peel and toasted almonds
Packed with intrigue and complexity*

PANEL NOTES:

COLOUR: Light old gold.

NOSE: Refreshingly zesty, then butterscotch travel sweets, vanilla brioche and a bracing herbal quality - mint fondant, eucalyptus and tarragon. Fresh tangerine to candied orange peel, with wonderfully bitter black cherries and cranberries. Warm toasted almonds. Espresso liqueur. Soft oak - freshly polished furniture.

PALATE: Warm vanilla caramel. Round with a buttery texture. Light peppery spice. Cloves. Gingersnaps. Bakewell tart. Orkney fudge. Ripe stone fruits, which turn more exotic: nectarine, kumquats, pineapple – spiced rum punch anyone? Complex and aromatic. Great length.

FINISH: Really, really moreish. Great balance of citrus freshness with both sweet and bitter fruits. This may be light by category, but it's long on complexity, depth and intrigue.
