NATURAL COLOUR. NON CHILL-FILTERED. 46%VOL.

SNIPPET:

*Fabulously juicy. Lush tropical fruit flowing into salted tablet, toasted hazelnuts and sandalwood - with a brilliantly long sweet/savoury interplay.*

PANEL NOTES:

**COLOUR:** Honeyed gold, hint of amber.

**NOSE:** Complex tropical fruit with fresh coconut, quince and aromatic stem ginger. Becomes mouthwateringly savoury, with Amontillado sherry trifle and griottine cherries, and then wonderfully nutty with milky fresh almonds; toasted hazelnuts and resinous sandalwood. The toasted sweetness continues with warm buttery shortbread, with a hint of nutmeg. Light minerality.

**TASTE:** Initially fragrant, minty, hint of cinnamon, spice and ginger, warming savoury sweetness - Highland toffee and muscovado sugar, bananas baked in rum. Mellow, with good length.

**IMPRESSION:** With the complex, juicy fruit and lip-smacking savouriness vying for attention, this is a moreish and intriguing single cask bottling. Great balance. A real gem.
