NATURAL COLOUR. NON CHILL-FILTERED. 46%VOL.

SNIPPET:

*Characteristically nutty and fragrant
Intriguingly both maritime and waxy
Rarely bottled as a single cask*

PANEL NOTES:

COLOUR: Mid-gold.

NOSE: Salty and wonderfully nutty - Frangelico (hazelnuts), roasted walnuts and fat macadamias - then spicy - cloves, star anise - and fragrant – frankincense and sandalwood. Fresh and zesty, balanced with lush vanilla sweetness: crème caramel and condensed milk. Rich and notably (candle) waxy. Coffee beans and dark chocolate with stem ginger. Dried rose petals. Really intriguing.

PALATE: Great maritime blast. Salted tablet. Intriguing waxy texture. Still quintessentially nutty and spicy – cinnamon (Mum's apple crumble) and cloves. Ripe fruit – bitter cherries and quince – to bakewell tart.

FINISH: Dry, but rich, long and complex. Warm golden syrup. Refreshing citrus lift. Quite unique !
